Announcement of the 13th Annual Meeting of the Society for Cultural Interaction in East Asia

The 13th International Academic Conference and Symposium of the Society for Cultural Interaction in East Asia will be held at Nishogakusha University, Japan, in May 2021.

Today's world is facing an unprecedented crisis of division. Religious issues, immigration issues and Britain's Brexit are intertwined. European countries are constantly divided. The political and economic crisis caused by the tension between the United States and China is becoming increasingly serious. Globally, there is no sign that the gap between rich and poor, population reduction, various forms of discrimination, natural disasters and other problems have been solved. In addition, the global pandemic of Covid-19 in 2020 seems to have further defined the contours of the problem, pushing humanity forward into a new stage of history, and at the same time forcing changes to 21st-century globalization and digitization agendas. Moreover, there has never been a time when wisdom needed so urgently to be gathered, when global thinking and global action needed such intelligent coordination.

Shibusawa Eiichi (1840 ~ 1931), known as the father of Japanese capitalism, traversed various fields of activity over the course of his life, from finance and industrial capitalism to lay diplomacy, philanthropy, philosophy, education and publishing. As Japan's economy falters after a century of extraordinary success, Shibusawa's legacy is inevitably - if unfairly - tainted. His book The Analects and the Abacus (1928), however, with its insistence on the dialectical unity of ethics and economics and its dialogical approach to intercultural learning, remains of utmost contemporary relevance. With the world facing multiple crises, we have decided to reexamine Shibusawa's legacy by making him the focus of our next General Assembly. Our venue, Nishogakusha University, will celebrate its 143rd anniversary in 2020. NU has a strong tradition in Japanese and Chinese classical scholarship. NU founder Mishima Chūshū is also widely known for his friendship with Shibusawa Eiichi.

Our call for papers, however, is not strictly limited to Shibusawa Eiichi. We welcome submissions from a wide range of perspectives, anything which will enrich the study of East Asian cultural interaction and East-West cultural interaction more broadly, as befitting the aims of the the Society since its inception.
